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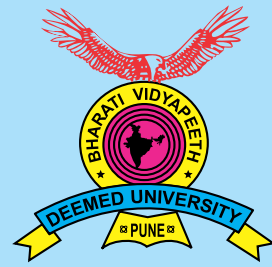

INDUSTRIAL VISIT

BVUSDE organized an industrial visit to Parle Biscuits PVT. LTD, Neemrana on 24 Sep 2013 (Tues). It was certainly a great experience and highly surprising to see all the theories we study in our books being put to practical use. We went to "Parle" factory at Neemrana which was highly enriching experience. About Industrial Visit Parle Products is an Indian private limited company. It owns the famous biscuit brand Parle-G. As of 2012[update], it had a 35% dominant share of the Indian biscuit market.

Students of BBA and BCA 1st semester visited the Parle -G factory at NEEMRANA to study their production , inventory management , HR and marketing systems .The Parle Coordinator explained the product mix of Parle and gave details about each brand via video. The students were taken over the gallery to see the production process , packaging and maintenance systems.

BVUSDE received by Anurag Srivastava, assistant HR manager of Parle Neemrana factory. We were shown a short animated film about the journey of Parle. The film explained us about the manufacturing of various Parle products like biscuits, confectionaries and chips. We were also briefed about the quality control, corporate social responsibility and other key management issues. The production unit at Neemrana mainly deals with the production of Parle-G one of the main product of Parle. It was great experience to witness the manufacturing process from one's own eyes. We visited the entire plant to understand the process clearly. The plant also encompasses a printing department where the wrappers are printed and then distributed to other production units of Parle. It was clearly evident that 5's theory is implemented in shop floor management. The smell of biscuits was so mesmerizing that I felt like having a lot of them. The main reason behind this industrial visit is to get practical knowledge and knowing industrial back round of business strategies .This report which I have made contains all the information that we come to know during the industrial visit and detail of various functions that took place on the industrial unit.



An industrial visit held on 24th September in PARLE PLANT which is situated at NEEMRANA (Rajasthan). We were 42 students with 4 faculty coordinators..Work place mgmt system has 5S. This technique comes from JAPAN. These are following:

- S-SEIKI - Recognition
- S-SEITON - Neatness
- S-SEISO - Cleanliness
- S-SEIKETSU - Standardization
- S-SHITSUK - Discipline.

They emphasis that they are parle family not plant workers. They have 70 units out of these 9 mother units. Main plants are in MUMBAI, BAHADURGARH, NIMBRANA, BHUJ & BANGLORE. They started business in 1928 with the idea of GERMENY. The founder of it MOHAN LAL DAYAL. At last they provide us product of parle-g biscuits as refreshment. It was great experience for us. We come at our college at 4:00pm.

It was fun to learn by observing the manufacturing process.

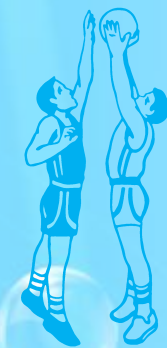
